

## Abstract submission

### General information

- Please register before submitting your abstract. In case you do not complete your payment on time (by April 15<sup>th</sup> 2027), your abstract may not be available in the abstract book.
- Each registered participant can submit two abstract as the presenting author. Number of co-authors is not limited.
- The Scientific Programme Committee (SPC) reserves the right to accept or reject abstracts, to decide whether to present them orally or as posters, and to select the appropriate session for their presentation.
- We would appreciate avoidance changing or withdrawing the abstract after the acceptance by SPC. If circumstances prevent attendance, the author should arrange the presentation to be made by a substitute.
- In case your abstract was not accepted, you have the right to cancel your registration to the congress free of charge.

### Content and Format

- The abstract should be prepared in English using the provided template.
- Name the template using your surname: if one abstract is submitted, use your surname; if two are submitted, add numbers (e.g., Johns1.docx; Johns2.docx).
- In order to engage with the audience try to use a strong and interesting title.
- List each author's name and surname without titles. Underline the presenting author's name and bold the corresponding author's name.
- For affiliations, please use following order: institution, department, country for each author.
- The total word count (body text) should not exceeding 300 words. It should cover the work's objective, methods, results, and conclusion. Use only standard abbreviations and provide data in widely accepted units, preferably the international metric system. Identify drug products by their generic names only.
- Include 3-5 key words not already included in the title.
- When submitting your abstract, please indicate your preferred presentation format - poster. The final decision on the presentation type will be made by SPC.
- All accepted abstracts will be published online in the CTDC13 abstract book.
- By submitting an abstract, you confirm acceptance of the submission rules, the scientific validity of your presentation, and that all authors have read and approved the abstract and its contents.
- Ensure that any human or animal work was ethically approved.
- Authors are responsible for the content and the language of their abstract. The publisher will not perform any corrections on the submission.

### Submission

- Please upload your abstract in a Microsoft Word format.
- Upon successful submission, you will receive a confirmation email. Please keep the email for future reference. If you do not receive the email, please contact the secretariat via email (ctdc13@gmail.com).
- The abstract can be modified or withdrawn before the acceptance.
- Together with your abstract submission, you may apply for a travel bursary or for one of the awards (more information - under the menu item 'Awards & Bursaries').

## **Review Process and Selection**

- Our expert reviewers will assess your abstract based on its scientific merit and relevance. You will receive an email notification about our decision, which is final and not subject to appeal.
- While some abstracts will be chosen for oral presentations, others will be accepted as posters or for publication only.
- You will be notified of the SPC's decision.
